The art mediums of Watercolor and Soft Pastels each have their own advantages and drawbacks.

Watercolor traditionally considered a drawing technique, has now achieved a status equal to oils. Nothing beats the ability of watercolor to immediately create almost magical effects of color. An unforgivable medium, what you lay on is what you get, and not easily corrected.

The pure pigments of *Soft Pastels* are perhaps the most vivid of all the artist colors. With no brushes to clean, the pigments are applied directly to the support for immediate, spontaneous results. Although the chalky dust is a problem for some.
